Question	Answer
1. What is <i>Consent Matters</i> ?	<p><i>Consent Matters</i> covers topics that have a focus on communication and relationships – such as consent in sexual relationships, as well as how to take action if you witness something happening on campus.</p> <p>All Macquarie students and staff can access and complete <i>Consent Matters</i> free of charge.</p>
2. Where can I find <i>Consent Matters</i> ?	<p><i>Consent Matters</i> can be found on iLearn, the University’s learning management system. It’s located specifically in the <i>Respect. Now. Always.</i> community site.</p> <p>The <i>Respect. Now. Always.</i> community site is a growing online portal for all students and staff to find out more about support services, workshops, and other resources in the area of preventing and responding to sexual assault and sexual harassment on campus.</p>
3. I’m already enrolled in the <i>Respect. Now. Always.</i> community site. How do I access <i>Consent Matters</i> ?	<p><i>Consent Matters</i> is the first link available on the main page of the site. You can click on the link to access and complete the online course.</p> <p> Consent Matters</p> <p>Consent Matters is an online course. It covers topics about communication and relationships, such as consent in sexual relationships, as well as how to take action as a bystander.</p> <p>Students at Macquarie are expected to have completed the course as part of their studies.</p> <p>To start the course, click on the link to open it. The course takes around 60 minutes to complete. You can complete part of it, and come back to complete the rest later.</p> <p>To complete the course, you need to do the Consent Matters Quiz and get 80% or higher.</p> <p>Interested in other education that is part of MQ RNA? Under this, there will be a button labelled “Enrol me”.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">No enrolment key required.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><input type="button" value="Enrol me"/></p> <p>Click the “Enrol me” button to self-enrol into the community site.</p> <p>Once you have self-enrolled, you will be able to access the community site. On the main page of the community site, you can find and click on the <i>Consent Matters</i> link to access and complete the online course.</p>
